## CANADA (2017 Gold Cup Record: 1W-1D-0L ... 5GF, 3GA)

- Last Time Out at the Gold Cup (GC): Canada 1, Costa Rica 1 ... 16-year-old Alphonso Davies became the first player to score a third goal in the tournament when he gave Canada the lead in the 26th minute ... Milan Borjan made 10 saves in a man-of-the-match performance to help Canada reach 4 points for first time since 2011 tournament
- 2017 Gold Cup results: 4-2 win v French Guiana (Dejan Jakovic 28'; Scott Arfield 45'+2; Alphonso Davies 60', 85'); 1-1 draw v Costa Rica (Alphonso Davies 26')
- Head Coach: Octavio Zambrano (since March 2017) ... the Ecuadorian is in his first national-team managerial job after a long club career ... spent six seasons as a head coach in Major League Soccer with LA Galaxy (1997-99) and MetroStars (2000-02)
- Gold Cup Appearances: 13 (1991, 1993, 1996, 2000, 2002, 2003, 2005, 2007, 2009, 2011, 2013, 2015, 2017) ... Gold Cup Record: GP-43; W-16; D-12; L-15; GF-48; GA-56 ... Qualification method: automatic North American entrant
- Best Finish: Champion-1 (2000) ... defeated Colombia, 2-0, in 2000 final (Jason De Vos 45'; Carlo Corazzin 68' pen) ... only team besides Mexico (7) and the United States (5) to win title ... Top GC Scorers: Dwayne De Rosario, Ali Gerba (6 goals each)
- 2018 FIFA World Cup Qualification: eliminated in fourth round (2W-1D-3L), finishing one point behind second-place Honduras in Group A ... overall qualifying record: GP-10; W-5, D-2, L-3; GF-15, GA-9 ... Cyle Larin and Tosaint Ricketts were team's joint-top scorers in 2018 WCQ play (4 goals) ... has not progressed to final round of CONCACAF qualifying since the 1998 World Cup cycle ... only World Cup appearance came at Mexico '86
- Performance against French Guiana marked the first time Canada had scored multiple goals in a GC match since a 2-2 draw against Costa Rica to close group play in 2009 (Patrice Bernier 25'; Marcel de Jong 28') ... has not allowed more than two goals in a GC game since a 4-1 loss to Brazil in 1996, a stretch of 35 matches
- Alphonso Davies: with brace v French Guiana, became youngest player to score in GC history (third youngest player in appear in a GC game) ... scored two goals for Vancouver Whitecaps FC in 2016/17 Scotiabank CONCACAF Champions League: game-winner (90'+3) in 2-1 away win v Sporting Kansas City on September 13, 2016 ... first goal (5') in 2-0 home win v New York Red Bulls in quarterfinal, second leg
- Conceded a goal per match or fewer in each of the previous four GC appearances (10 goals in 13 matches)
- GC record against Central American opposition: GP-16; W-5; D-8; L-2; GF-19; GA-15 ... drawn five consecutive games against Central American foes
- GC record in closing group matches: GP-11; W-3; D5; L-3; GF-11; GA-14 ... drawn last four matches to close group play, the last two scoreless
- Before setting new team record with four GC goals v French Guiana, have scored three goals in a GC match three times, including twice against Central American opponents (3-1 win v Honduras on Jan. 10, 1996; 3-0 win v Guatemala on June 16, 2007)
- Four players on roster have scored in GC (including 2017): Alphonso Davies (3 goals); Scott Arfield, Patrice Bernier, Marcel de Jong, Dejan Jakovic (1)
- Hasn't won two-consecutive matches in same GC since 2009

## HONDURAS (2017 Gold Cup Record: 1W-0D-1L ... 3GF, 1GA)

- Last Time Out at the Gold Cup (GC): Honduras 0, French Guiana 0 ... In first-ever GC meeting, game ended in a scoreless draw ... Early Friday morning, however, the CONCACAF Gold Cup Disciplinary Committee awarded Honduras a 3-0 victory due to French Guiana fielding an ineligible player (Florent Malouda)
- 2017 Gold Cup results: 0-1 loss v Costa Rica; 3-0 win v French Guiana (forfeit, original result: 0-0 draw)
- Head Coach: Jorge Luis Pinto (Colombia) ... since 2014 ... in second stint in charge of Costa Rica, led the Ticos to 2014 World Cup quarterfinals, team's best-ever finish
- Gold Cup Appearances: 13 (1991, 1993, 1996, 1998, 2000, 2003, 2005, 2007, 2009, 2011, 2013, 2015, 2017) ... Gold Cup record: GP-46; W-18; D-8; L-20; GF-67; GA-59 ... Best Finish: Runner-up-1 (1991) ... Top GC Scorer: Carlos Pavon (9 goals) ... Qualification method: Champion, 2017 Copa Centroamericana (Record: GP-5; W-4, D-1; L-0; GF-7; GA-3)
- 2017 Copa Centroamericana results: 2-1 win v Nicaragua, 2-1 win v El Salvador, 1-0 win v Panama, 1-1 draw v Costa Rica, 1-0 win v Belize
- 2017 Copa Centroamericana scorers: Eddie Hernandez (3 goals); Erick Andino, Roman Castillo (2) ... Hernandez won tournament's Golden Boot and midfielder Jorge Claros won Golden Ball ... fourth Copa Centroamericana title (trails only Costa Rica, 8 titles)
- 2018 FIFA World Cup Qualifying (WCQ): currently in fifth place in fifth round of CONCACAF qualifying ... Fifth-round record: GP-6; W-1; D-2; L-3; GF-6; GA-14 ... Overall qualifying record: GP-12; W-3, D-4; L-5; GF-12; GA-20
- CONCACAF WCQ fifth round results: 0-1 loss v Panama (H), 3-1 win v Trinidad and Tobago (H), 6-0 loss v United States (A), 1-1 draw v Costa Rica (H), 3-0 loss v Mexico (A), 2-2 draw v Panama (H) ... Remaining matches: Trinidad & Tobago (A), United States (H), Costa Rica (A), Mexico (H)
- Seven goals in 2018 WCQ cycle have been scored by Houston Dynamo trio of Romell Quioto (4), Alberth Elis (2) and Oscar Boniek Garcia (1) ... Five players on Honduras roster have scored in a previous GC: Maynor Figueroa - 1 v Trinidad & Tobago (2005); Alfredo Mejia - 1 v Grenada (2011); Jorge Claros - 1 v El Salvador (2013); Rony Martinez - 1 v Haiti (2013); Carlos Discua - 1 v USA (2015)
- Excluding 3-0 forfeit win v French Guiana, has scored one goal or fewer in last eight GC matches dating back to 2013
- Advanced beyond group stage in five straight GC editions, before failing to do so in 2015, ending run of three straight trips to the semifinals ... last failed to reach knockout phase in consecutive tournaments when exiting after the first round in 1993, 1996 and 1998
- One of only two nations in GC history that has a positive all-time goal differential (plus-8), but a losing tournament record (Costa Rica is the other)
- GC record against North American opposition: GP-15; W-3; D-3; L-9; GF-12; GA-23 ... lost four straight GC games against North American teams since defeating Canada 1-0 in 2009 quarterfinals ... never lost to a North American opponent by more than two goals or conceded more than three against one
- GC record in final match of group play: W-4; D-2; L-6 ... lost three straight group finales ... Nine of 13 goals scored in group-stage finales came in just two matches: 5-0 win v Cuba (June 13, 2007); 4-0 win v Grenada (July 11, 2009)

## CONCACAF Gold Cup – Advancement of Teams from Group Stage

*(excerpted directly from 2017 competition regulations, page 29)*

2. The top two teams from each of the three groups and the two best third-place teams shall qualify for the Quarterfinals.
3. The ranking of each team in each group will be determined as follows:
  - a. Greatest number of points obtained in group matches
  - b. Goal difference in all group matches
  - c. Greatest number of goals scored in all group matches
  - d. Greatest number of points obtained in group matches between the teams concerned;
  - e. Drawing of lots by the Gold Cup Committee.
4. Ranking for the two best third place teams will be determined as follows:
  - a. Greatest number of points obtained in group matches;
  - b. Goal difference in all group matches;
  - c. Greatest number of goals scored in all group matches;
  - d. Drawing of lots by the Gold Cup Committee.
5. The 8 teams that qualify from the group stage will contest the quarterfinals as follows:

Winner A vs. Second B (1A vs. 2B)	=	Winner 1
Winner B vs. Best Third A or C (1B vs. 3A/3C)	=	Winner 2
Winner C vs. Best Third A or B (1C vs. 3A/3B)	=	Winner 3
Second C vs. Second A (2C vs 2A)	=	Winner 4
