UNITED STATES (2017 Gold Cup Overall Record: 4W-1D-0L ... 11GF, 3GA)

- Last Time Out at the Gold Cup (GC): United States 2, Costa Rica 0 ... Clint Dempsey scored one goal (57th U.S./13th GC) and assisted on Jozy Altidore's opener as the United States earned a place in its record-extending 10th Gold Cup final
- 2017 Gold Cup Results: 1-1 draw v Panama (Dom Dwyer 50'); 3-2 win v Martinique (Omar Gonzalez 54'; Jordan Morris 64', 76'); 3-0 win v Nicaragua (Joe Corona 36'; Kelyn Rowe 56'; Matt Miazga 88'); 2-0 win v El Salvador (Omar Gonzalez 41'; Eric Lichaj 45'+2); 2-0 win v Costa Rica (Jozy Altidore 72', Clint Dempsey 82')
- Gold Cup Appearances: 14 (1991, 1993, 1996, 1998, 2000, 2002, 2003, 2005, 2007, 2009, 2011, 2013, 2015, 2017) ... Gold Cup Record: GP-72; W-55; D-9; L-8; GF-145; GA-52 (72 games played and 55 wins are Gold Cup records) ... Best Finish: Champion-5 (1991, 2002, 2005, 2007, 2013)
- Top GC Scorers: Landon Donovan (18 goals), Clint Dempsey (13 goals) ... Donovan is tournament's all-time leading scorer ... Dempsey's last goal tied him with Donovan for most international goals scored by a USA player (57) ... It also moved him one ahead of Mexico's Luis Roberto Alves into sole possession of second-place on the GC scoring list
- 2018 FIFA World Cup Qualifying (WCQ): 3rd place, CONCACAF fifth round (GP-6; W-2; D-2; L-2; GF-11, GA-8)
- 2018 FIFA WCQ, CONCACAF fifth round results: 0-2 home loss v Mexico; 0-4 away loss v Costa Rica; 6-0 home win v Honduras; 1-1 away draw v Panama; 2-0 home win v Trinidad & Tobago; 1-1 away draw v Mexico ... Remaining fifth-round matches: Costa Rica (H); Honduras (A); Panama (H); Trinidad & Tobago (A)
- Made maximum allowed six roster changes before knockout phase ... IN: Clint Dempsey (FW), Jozy Altidore (FW), Michael Bradley (MF), Darlington Nagbe (MF), Tim Howard (GK), Jesse Gonzalez (GK) ... OUT: Dom Dwyer (FW), Kelyn Rowe (MF), Cristian Roldan (MF), Alejandro Bedoya (MF), Sean Johnson (GK), Brad Guzan (GK)
- Scored at least one goal in 23 consecutive Gold Cup matches, longest active streak among 2017 GC entrants (Mexico holds GC record, scoring in 31 consecutive games: July 20, 2003-July 9, 2015) ... last shutout in 0-5 loss to Mexico in 2009 final, which was USA's largest margin of defeat in Gold Cup history ... advanced to GC final in 10 of 14 appearances (2000)
- GC Final Record: GP-9; W-3; D-2; L-4; GF-7; GA-15 ... All four GC final defeats have come during five final meetings against Mexico (GF-4; GA-14) ... Twice won final on penalties after dueling to a scoreless draw (1991, 2005)
- Five titles are second-most in GC history (Mexico #1: 7) ... Record 10 GC finals (Mexico #2: 8)
- July 22, 2015: 1-2 GC semifinal loss v Jamaica (Michael Bradley 47') marked first time USA failed to reach final since 2003
- Last win v Jamaica (2017 friendly): February 3, 2017 – United States 1 (Jordan Morris 58'), Jamaica 0
- Record against Caribbean opposition: GP 20; W-18; D-1; L-1; GF-53; GA-12 ... faced 18 consecutive Caribbean sides without defeat before 1-2 loss v Jamaica in 2015 GC semifinals
- Posted shutouts in last three GC matches, after going four matches without keeping a clean sheet for first time in tournament history (team record for consecutive shutouts: 7 games from January 21, 2002-July 19, 2003)
- Eight players on current roster have scored in GC: Clint Dempsey (13); Michael Bradley, Joe Corona, Omar Gonzalez, Jozy Altidore (3); Jordan Morris (2); Gyasi Zardes, Eric Lichaj (1)
- Five players on current roster have scored in the Scotiabank CONCACAF Champions League (SCCL): Paul Arriola (2, Club Tijuana); Clint Dempsey (2, Seattle Sounders FC); Omar Gonzalez (2, LA Galaxy); Chris Pontius (3, D.C. United); Gyasi Zardes (1, LA Galaxy) ... Omar Gonzalez has never scored an international goal outside GC play
- Omar Gonzalez won 2016/17 SCCL title (Pachuca) & 2013 Gold Cup (USA) ... 4 all-time league titles (3, LA Galaxy, MLS; 1, Pachuca, Liga MX)
- Clint Dempsey's goal against Costa Rica was the first of tournament scored directly off a free kick. One day later, Jamaica's Kemar Lawrence scored the second in the other GC semifinal
- Head Coach: Bruce Arena (since November 2016) ... Arena began his second stint in charge of the U.S. in November 2016, taking over from Jurgen Klinsmann ... previously managed the side from 1998-2006, guiding U.S. to 2002 FIFA World Cup quarterfinals & two GC titles (2002, 2005) ... winningest coach in GC history (16W-4D-1L) ... attempting to become first head coach to win three GC titles (Bora Milutinovic also has two: 1991-USA, 1996-Mexico)

- Last Time Out at the Gold Cup (GC): Mexico 0, Jamaica 1 ... Kemar Lawrence's curling 88th-minute free kick lifted Jamaica to a second consecutive and second all-time GC final appearance ... Goalkeeper Andre Blake made five saves to record his third shutout of tournament.
- 2017 Gold Cup results: 2-0 win v Curacao (Romario Williams 58'; Darren Mattocks 73'); 0-0 draw v Mexico; 1-1 draw v El Salvador (Darren Mattocks 64' pen); 2-1 win v Canada (Shaun Francis 6'; Romario Williams 50'); 1-0 win v Mexico (Kemar Lawrence 88')

- Only previous GC final – July 26, 2015: Mexico 3 (Andres Guardado 31'; Jesus Corona 46'; Oribe Peralta 60'), Jamaica 1 (Darren Mattocks 78') ... marked best Caribbean GC finish, besting previous semifinal appearances by Jamaica (1993, 1998), Guadeloupe (2007) and Trinidad & Tobago (2000)
- Only three players on current roster appeared in 2015 final v Mexico (1-3 loss) ... Kemar Lawrence (played all 90 mins.) & Je-Vaughn Watson (subbed out in 88th min., yellow card in 23rd min.) started, Darren Mattocks came on as second-half substitute (59th min. for Garath McCleary)
- Attempting to be first nation outside North America to win a GC title ... one of two CONCACAF member nations outside North America to reach multiple finals (Panama is the other) ... one of four CONCACAF member nations outside North America to reach final (Panama 2005, 2013; Honduras 1991; Costa Rica 2002; Jamaica 2015, 2017)
- GC record against North American opponents: GP-16; W-4; D-1; L-11; GF-12; GA-32 ... record against North American opponents includes all six knockout round defeats and three out of four knockout round victories
- Record in last two GC tournaments against North American teams: GP-6; W-4; D-1; L-1; GF-7, GA-5 ... Only loss in came in 2015 GC final ... Will face all three North American nations for a second consecutive tournament ... Attempting to become the first team ever to beat
- Last win v United States (2015 Gold Cup semifinal): July 22, 2015 – United States 1 (Michael Bradley 47'), Jamaica 2 (Giles Barnes 30'; Darren Mattocks 35') ... Attempting to become first CONCACAF team to defeat United States and Mexico in the same GC tournament
- Andre Blake: 2016 Major League Soccer Goalkeeper of the Year with the Philadelphia Union ... posted seven shutouts thus far in 2017 MLS campaign ... recorded all three clean sheets for Jamaica in 2017 GC
- Kemar Lawrence: started 58 of 59 regular-season MLS games since joining New York Red Bulls in 2015 ... played in five games during 2016/17 CONCACAF Champions League ... Lawrence's goal against Mexico was just the second of 2017 GC scored directly off a corner kick ... the first came one day earlier in other semifinal, by USA's Clint Dempsey
- Darren Mattocks: made Jamaica debut in 2-0 win v El Salvador on August 15, 2012 ... only player on Jamaica's 2017 roster to have scored in a previous GC edition
- Unbeaten in 14 of last 16 Gold Cup matches ... conceded one goal or fewer in 15 of last 18 Gold Cup games, including 10 shutouts (9W-1D-0L in those shutouts) ... recorded only three shutouts in first 22 Gold Cup outings ... two of 40 all-time Gold Cup matches ended in scoreless draws (1998 v Brazil, 2017 v Mexico) ... 10W-2D-3L record when scoring in 1st half of a GC game
- Head Coach: Theodore Whitmore (since September 2016) ... in 4th spell as Jamaica manager, the longest running from 2009-13 ... most recently assumed the role following the departure of Winfried Schaefer, who guided Jamaica to the 2015 Gold Cup final ... only person to win Caribbean Cup as player and head coach ... scored both goals in Jamaica's 2-1 win over Japan in 1998 World Cup (39', 54')
