- This will be their 4th meeting. First meeting was in 1974 at the Central American and Caribbean Games in the Dominican Republic, a 2-3 win for Bermuda.
- Have faced each other twice in Gold Cup Qualifying. In 2006 Caribbean Cup, Group C, in US Virgin Islands. Bermuda won 3-1, goals from Aljame Zuill, Darius Cox and Kwame Steede (BER); Jonathan Faña (DOM). Also, 2016 Caribbean Cup, 2nd round in Bermuda, 1-0 win for Dominican Republic, goal from Jonathan Faña.
- Dominican Republic (DOM) has 6 points in CNLQ. Beat Bonaire 5-0 in Week 1, 3-0 vs. Cayman Islands in Week 2, lost 1-0 vs. Cuba in Week 3. Winning would all but ensure 2019 Gold Cup berth.
- Bermuda (BER) has 6 points in CNLQ. Lost 3-1 vs. Aruba in Week 1, and beat Sint Maarten 12-0 in Week 2 and beat El Salvador 1-0 in Week 3. A win would all but ensure berth in 2019 Gold Cup.
- **Domingo Peralta (DOM):** Leads team in scoring in CNLQ, 3 goals.
- **Zeiko Lewis and Reggie Lambe (BER):** Lead team in scoring in CNLQ, 3 goals each in 3 games. Each scored a hat trick vs. Sint Maarten in Week 2.
- **Jean Carlos López (DOM):** Leads team in completed passes in CNLQ. 131.
- **Nahki Wells (BER):** Scored winning goal in 1-0 win vs. El Salvador in Week 3.
